Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking direction to official respondent No. 2 not to harass the petitioners at the hands of respondent No. 5.

2. It is, *inter alia*, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that respondent No. 5 had filed a complaint against the petitioners which after thorough inquiry was filed but in order to harass the petitioners, respondent No. 5 has again preferred another complaint and in this regard, the petitioners have moved a representation dated 25/27.09.2023 (Annexure P-1) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka. But no action till date has been taken thereon.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioners will be satisfied if the directions are issued to respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, to consider and decide the representation 25/27.09.2023 (Annexure P-1) in an

expeditious manner.

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4. Notice of motion.
5. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Swati Batra, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of State-respondents No. 1 to 4.
6. After hearing the respective submissions; considering the averments made in the petition and without commenting on the merits thereon, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 25/27.09.2023 (Annexure P-1) and dispose of the same in an expeditious manner under the provisions of the law.
7. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioners.
