JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

The petitioner through instant petition is seeking quashing of Complaint No.64 dated 07.12.2010 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 304B, 302, 120B, 218 and 219 of IPC, 1860 and summoning order dated 24.02.2016 (Annexure P-2) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that police in its investigation did not find any substance in the allegations of respondent No.2-complainant. The complainant thereafter preferred impugned complaint and Trial Court vide impugned order dated 24.02.2016 summoned the petitioner. The complainant has already appeared before the Trial Court and made statement regarding compromise in favour of the petitioner. The complainant has no more grievance against the petitioner, however, trial is continuing on account of summoning order which cannot be recalled by the Trial Court.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Trial Court to decide the trial expeditiously after considering changed facts and circumstances including compromise executed between the parties.
