Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellants submits that keeping in view the instructions received from the State vide letter dated 12.05.2023, the present appeal may be allowed to be withdrawn with liberty to implement the judgments and decrees of the Courts below so as to extend the benefits to late Malkiat Singh for the period he remained alive by treating him to be in continuous service along with the grant of all consequential benefits for the service period upto his death and after the death of Malkiat Singh, all the service benefits for which the legal heirs are entitled, will be paid to the respondents-plaintiffs along with the arrears of family pension in favour of the wife of the deceased. Learned State counsel submits that all the benefits will be released within a period of two months from today.

Keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the State recorded hereinbefore, the present appeal is allowed to be withdrawn keeping in view the undertaking of the learned State counsel recorded hereinbefore.
