Through this petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.0139, dated 11.09.2022, under Sections 379-A, 34 and 411 IPC, registered at Police Station South Sector 34, Chandigarh.

Affidavit of CPS, SDPO South, Chandigarh in terms of the pervious order; along with the custody certificate have been placed on record. Allegations are that petitioner along with co-accused Avdesh snatched the mobile phone from the complainant-Pankaj Kashyap on 11.09.2022. The snatched mobile was recovered from co-accused Avdesh. The role attributed to the petitioner is that he had grabbed the cycle of the complainant.

It is submitted by learned State counsel that the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents.

Heard.

Having regard to the role attributed to the petitioner and the fact that he has no criminal antecedents the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/trial Court, Chandigarh.
