DEEPAK GUPTA J. (ORAL)

On 07.10.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.54, dated 28.06.2023, under Sections 323, 325, 451, 452 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the only attribution to the petitioner is to have given a ghapa blow, which hit on the little finger of the right hand of the complainant.

Notice of motion.

Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A copy of paper book be supplied to him during the course of day. Adjourned to 04.12.2023. for filing status report.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join investigation and co-operate in the same. He will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor shall make any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any witness associated with the case. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer.

He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Today, on instructions from ASI Dalbir Singh, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 07.10.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 07.10.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
