The present petition has been filed for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in respect of FIR No.79 dated 17.06.2021 under Sections 21,29,61,85 of the NDPS Act 1985 registered at police Station Sarhali, Tehsil and District Tarn Taran.

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that out of the total 11 cited witnesses, 08 witnesses have already been examined and the remaining 03 witnesses have also been summoned for examination on 30.10.2023 hence, the trial is likely to be concluded shortly.

Keeping in view the above, as out of the total 11 cited witnesses, 08 witnesses have already been examined, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial within a period of one month from the next

date of hearing so that the petitioner does not suffer indefinite incarceration.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the direction given by this Court, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to revive the same in case the direction given by this Court is not complied with.
