Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.066 dated 25.09.2022, under Sections 457, 380 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Majri, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Vide order dated 30.11.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 30.11.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation. She further submits that in FIR No.82 dated 21.12.2022, under Sections 21 and 22 of NDPS Act, 1985, Police Station Majri, SAS Nagar (Mohali), the petitioner has been granted regular bail vide order dated 31.01.2023 passed by the court of learned Special Judge, SAS Nagar, as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The copy of the aforesaid order has been produced by the learned counsel for the petitioner, which is taken on record. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI -Paramjeet Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 30.11.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
