The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct the respondents No.1 to 3 to safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioners as they apprehend imminent threat at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Mr. Madhur Singh, Legal Aid Counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent No.5 and has filed the Vakalatnama and the same is taken on record.

In response to the averments made in the petition, the learned State counsel has filed the reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar. Learned State counsel submits that one FIR No.628 dated 05.11.2022, under Section 365 of IPC has been registered at Police Station City, Jagadhari as the petitioner No.1 is a minor. He further submits that during the course of investigation, the petitioner No.2 has been arrested and is behind the bars. Statement of petitioner No.1 has been recorded under Section

164 Cr. PC. He further informs the Court that petitioner No.1 who is present in the Court, is staying with the parents of petitioner No.2 voluntarily. He further submits that the petitioner No.1 has clearly stated during the course of investigation that she does not have any threat to her life and liberty, whereas petitioner No.2 is in custody.

In view of the said submissions, no further orders are required and the present petition is accordingly disposed off.
