HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is entitled for the grant of 2nd as well as 3rd ACP from the dates, she became eligible for along with the arrears and interest.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that without any valid justification, the said benefit has not been extended to the petitioner, which is causing prejudice to her, hence, the respondents be directed to grant the petitioner the benefit as being claimed in the present writ petition.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of the grievance as raised in the present petition, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 23.08.2023 (Annexure P-7) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to respondents

to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the representation dated 23.08.2023 (Annexure P-7) has been received and is still pending with the respondents, the same will be decided by respondents within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, after the decision of the representation, any benefit accrues to the petitioner, the same will also be released to her within a further period of four weeks.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

8. Ordered accordingly.
