Petitioner has approached this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari praying for quashing the impugned show cause notice dated 27.09.2023 (Annexure P-2) being illegal, arbitrary, void ab initio as the similar matter is sub judice before the Waqaf Tribunal Ambala between the same parties qua the same land. Further prayer has been made for issuance of direction to the respondents to pay the compensation for the harassment being caused to the petitioner for their illegal and arbitrary actions as stated in the writ petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the above-mentioned fact, reply has already been filed but no action has been taken till date.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State. Mr. Prateek Mahajan, Advocate with Ms. Saloni Sharma, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of

respondent No.2. He has submitted that the property belongs to the Waqaf Board on which the encroachment has been made by the petitioner.

Heard. After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, it is apparent that the petitioner has already filed his reply in response to the notice issued by respondent No.3. In the facts and circumstances of the present petition, same is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to take a final decision on the notice issued taking into consideration the reply filed by the petitioner. The notice also discloses that the property belongs to the Waqaf Board. If so advised, respondent No.2 be also heard and after the decision taken, respondent No.3, same would be communicated to the petitioner forthwith.
