[1] At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner confines the prayer in this petition to a time bound decision on the representation dated 28.09.2023 (Annexure P-1) by Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2.

[2] Notice of motion to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 only at this stage.

[3] Mr. Amish Sharma, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf the respondent Nos.1 to 3 and waives service. Learned State counsel states that respondent No.2 would dispose of the representation, in accordance with law, within the stipulated time.
