1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to renew his passport.

2. The petitioner was issued passport which expired on 13.11.2006. The petitioner applied for re-issuance of passport on 02.08.2022. Eight FIRs came to be registered against the petitioner. The petitioner has already been acquitted in 7 FIRs and police has filed cancellation report in 8th FIR which stands accepted by the Trial Court on 01.04.2015.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that case of the petitioner is squarely covered by judgment of this Court in ***Mohan Lal @ Mohna vs. Union of India and others 2023 SCC Online P&H 1391.***

4. Learned counsel for the respondents-UOI submits that case

of the petitioner would be considered and disposed of within 6 weeks from today, considering judgment of this Court in *Mohan Lal @ Mohna* (supra).

5. In the wake of statements of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
