The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.292 dated 14.06.2023 under Sections 420 IPC and Sections 3, 7, 10 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 and Sections 5, 6, 25, 28 and 35 of the Fertilizer Movement Order, 1985 registered at Police Station Sadar Yamuna Nagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 06.10.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

A short reply dated 13.11.2023 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajender submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 06.10.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

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In this view of the matter, interim order dated 06.10.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
