1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the authorities to get the amount disbursed to respondents No.4 to 10 returned, and further directing respondent No.3 to refer the dispute to District Judge, Rohtak, with certain other prayers made in the present petition.

2. Since the compensation amount has been disbursed to respondents No.4 to 10 only qua their rights, as were available in the record or as determined by the Court, therefore, no order for return of the compensation paid to respondents No.4 to 10 can be made, at this stage.

3. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.

4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to file a separate petition seeking reference on his application, if any, moved before the concerned Land Acquisition Collector.
