The instant writ petition has been filed for seeking quashing of the order dated 15.10.2019 (Annexure P-9) vide which the respondents have blacklisted the vehicle bearing registration No.PB-31D-6061 for a period of two years and the staff of the petitioner firm was blacklisted for lifetime on industry basis.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the blacklisting of the vehicle bearing registration No.PB-31D-6061 was for a period of two years commencing w.e.f. 06.05.2019 to 05.05.2021 and the said period has already come to an end. He further points out that he does not press the instant petition at this stage on the said aspect including the aspect of blacklisting the contractual employees. He, however, submits that the only grievance which subsists now in the present case is that the vehicle

in question should not be deemed blacklisted after the expiry of above said period of two years.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that since the order of blacklisting for only for a period of 06.05.2019 to 05.05.2021, hence, for all future references of the Company, the above order of blacklisting does not enure any further.

In view of the aforesaid statement, the present petition is disposed of as not pressed, at this stage.
