HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioner (Chand Mohammad) has filed the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking modification of order dated 20.12.2018 (Annexure P-3) and grant of full back wages and compensation to the petitioner-workman on account of illegal termination of his services by respondent No.6. A further prayer has been made to direct respondent No.6 to consider the seniority of petitioner-workman and reinstate him with continuity in service and also to release arrears and revise the fitment salary of the petitioner-workman.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties concerned, and accordingly, he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
