DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

This first petition filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 151 dated 29.10.2022 registered under Sections 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Cantt, Bathinda, District Bathinda and for staying the arrest of the petitioners till the pendency of the petition.

Status report by way of affidavit of Gurpreet Singh Gill, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-2 Bathinda, District Bathinda, on behalf of respondent-State has been filed and same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per the directions of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and he is no more required for further investigation in the present case. It has also been contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Investigating Officer, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not

required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 12.12.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
