This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in a case bearing FIR No.245 dated 11.12.2019 under Sections 498-A/406/120-B IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Notice of motion was issued on 18.11.2022 and the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

On 24.04.2023, the following order was passed:-

‘Learned counsel for the petitioner is requesting for adjournment as the matter has been compromised. However, status report filed by respondent-State is taken on record, copy thereof, supplied to opposite party.’

Adjourned to 14.07.2023.

Photocopy of this order be placed on the file of another connected case.

Interim order to continue till next date.'

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The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Seharpal Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation. She further submits that even the parties have filed a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act for dissolution of marriage on mutual consent and the first motion statement has already been recorded.

In view of the statement of learned State counsel, order dated 18.11.2022 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
