The instant petition has been filed for issuance of appropriate directions to official respondent Nos.1 to 4 to take appropriate action in FIR No. 147 dated 09.09.2021 registered under Sections 420/406/120-B of Indian Penal Code and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professional Act, 2014 registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar Rural.

In compliance of order dated 17.11.2022, status report by way of affidavit of Surinder Pal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, DSP, Sub-Division Kartarpur, District Jalandhar on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5-State has been filed and same is taken on record.

As per status report filed on behalf of Respondent Nos.1 to 5, learned State counsel submits that after the registration of FIR, raids at the hideouts of respondent Nos.6 and 7 were conducted, however, they are still at large. It is further submitted that the IO has got issued, non-bailable warrants of respondent No.6 and 7 to join investigation. Also, as per the

enquiry, respondent No.6 has admitted that he has taken Rs.12,00,000/- from the petitioner on the pretext of sending him to Canada. It is further submitted that efforts are being made by police officials to arrest respondent Nos.6 and 7 and they shall be arrested soon.

Since, the non-bailable warrants have been issued against respondent Nos.6 and 7 and raids are also being conducted, nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present petition.

In view thereof, present petition is disposed of as such with no order.
