Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.119 dated 18.09.2022, registered under Section 304 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code(for short 'IPC'), at Police Station, Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to earlier order dated 16.11.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and has fully cooperated in the same.

3. Learned State counsel per his instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh submits that petitioner has joined investigation and in view of cooperation rendered by her, no custodial interrogation of petitioner is required.

4. In view of the above, since custodial interrogation of petitioner is no more required and she has already joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating officer, present petition is allowed. Order dated 16.11.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to petitioner's complying with provisions under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
