1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 08.08.2023 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.1 whereby the petition filed by respondent No.2 under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 and Rules 2012 has been allowed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since, the matter has been remanded back in view of the fact that purchasers-Inderjeet Singh and Rajesh Kumar Sharma were not made party thus, he seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present Civil Writ Petition with liberty to the petitioner to pursue the case before the Maintenance Tribunal-cum-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Nabha. It is further prayed that since the

petitioner is a 73 years old widow thus, the Maintenance Tribunal-cum-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Nabha before whom the matter has been remanded, be directed to decide the case after remand as expeditiously as possible preferably within a time frame.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to pursue the case before the Maintenance Tribunal-cum-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Nabha. The Maintenance Tribunal-cum-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Nabha is directed to decide the case in pursuance of order dated 08.08.2023 as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.
