The instant petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.45 dated 04.03.2021 registered under Sections 307, 326, 325, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC, at Police Station Division No. 8, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 05.05.2023 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation.
