The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent No.1 to decide the statutory departmental appeals dated 19.06.2023 (Annexures P-2 and P-3) and 22.09.2023 (Annexures P-7 and P-8) respectively filed against the punishment orders dated 22.03.2023 (Annexure P-1) and 21.06.2023 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.2 being Punishing Authority in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioners at the outset prays for deciding the appeals filed by the petitioners No. 1 and 2 dated 19.06.2023 (Annexures P-2 and P-3) and 22.09.2023 (Annexures P-7 and P-8), expeditiously by passing a speaking order within a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On receipt of advance notice, Mr. Karan Singla, Advocate has put in appearance in Court today, accepts notice on behalf of respondents and submits that the appeals annexed with the petition dated 19.06.2023 (Annexures P-2 and P-3) and 22.09.2023 (Annexures P-7 and P-8) respectively filed by the petitioners shall be decided within one year.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the case file.

The Appellate Authority-respondent No.1 is directed to consider and decide the appeals dated 19.06.2023 (Annexures P-2 and P-3) and 22.09.2023 (Annexures P-7 and P-8) respectively qua the petitioners, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of one year from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Since the statutory appeals filed by the petitioners are still pending and yet to be decided, it will be in the interest of justice that no further recovery be effected from them.

The petition stands disposed of.
