SANJIV BERRY, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for quashing of FIR No. 0231 dated 16.09.2019, under Sections 427 and 379-B(2) of IPC registered at Police Station Jandiala, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising there from on the basis of compromise dated 11.10.2019 (Annexure P-2) executed between the parties.

2. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the parties have arrived at a settlement vide compromise deed dated 11.10.2019 (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, vide report dated 22.11.2019, has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

3. Respondent No. 2 is represented by his counsel and does not

oppose the compromise.

4. In view of the report of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in “Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and “Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”, (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the complainants has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioners/ accused persons.

5. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 0231 dated 16.09.2019, under Sections 427 and 379-B(2) of IPC registered at Police Station Jandiala, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise qua the present petitioners, however, subject to cost of Rs.10,000/- to be paid by the petitioner within a period of one month from today. The cost shall be deposited in the following account: -

5. It is made clear that the aforesaid quashing shall be subject to deposit of the cost stated above.
