Application is allowed as prayed for, subject to just exceptions.

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The petitioners had filed the present petition with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their lives and liberty as they apprehend imminent threat at the hands of respondents No.4 to 13.

A short reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Shri Chamkur Sahib, District Rupnagar has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the statement of respondent No.4 i.e. the father of petitioner No.1 was recorded and he is stated in the said statement that his youngest daughter, namely, Arashdeep Kaur that is

petitioner No.1 had left the house on 21st October 2022 without his knowledge and thereafter, he has come to know that her daughter had been living with petitioner No.2. Respondent No.4 further stated that he had disinherited the petitioner No.1 from his moveable or immovable properties and he and his family have no relation with petitioner No.1. He further assured that he would not interfere in her life in any manner at any point of time. Even respondents No.5 to 8 had got their statements recorded and made statement on similar lines. He further submits that as per the enquiry conducting by the police, the petitioners do not face any threat either from their parents or relatives.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be passed and the present petition is accordingly disposed of.
