Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.495 dated 8.10.2022 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 427, 452, 506 IPC at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

On the last date of hearing, detailed order was passed and the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join the investigation.

Today, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of the previous order of interim bail. State counsel on instructions from HC Sunil Kumar apprised the Court that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 16.11.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
