ANIL KSHETARPAL, J

1. The petitioner herein is the defendant in a pending suit for grant of decree of separate possession.
2. An application filed by the plaintiffs for permission to amend the plaint was allowed. The petitioner was given an opportunity to file the written statement to the amended plaint. However, he changed his entire stand while filing the reply to the amended plaint. The trial Court has held that such amendments that change the whole stand in the written statement are not permissible under the garb of filing reply to the amended plaint.
3. The learned counsel representing the petitioner faced with the aforesaid situation prays for permission to withdraw the present revision petition in order to file an application for permission to amend the written statement before the trial court.
4. The learned counsel representing the respondents has no objection.

5. In view of the aforesaid facts, the revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file an application for permission to amend the written statement, which shall be considered by the trial court in accordance with law.

6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
