The petitioner has preferred the instant appeal challenging the order dated 5.11.2022 vide which the petition filed by the appellant under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.326 dated 05.10.2022 registered under Sections 3(1)(C) of SC&ST (Prevention of Atrocities Act), 1989, at Police Station Kotwali, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that in compliance of the order dated 18.11.2022, the appellant has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh has stated that the appellant has joined investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the respondent, the present appeal is allowed and the interim order dated 18.11.2022 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
