

4. Contends that petitioner has not been attributed any injury attracting Section 326 IPC; nor anything has been recovered from him. Also contends that petitioner is an innocent person and has been falsely implicated in the case. Lastly, contends that petitioner is ready to join investigation as such deserves concession of pre-arrest bail.

5. Per contra, learned State counsel, while opposing the prayer of petitioner, submitted that his custodial interrogation is required for recovery of weapon of offence. Hence, the present petition deserves to be dismissed.

6. A perusal of the aforesaid report reveals that injured-Hardeep Kumar @ Kaka had suffered various injuries, which are detailed in Para 3 of the status report (supra) and which are extracted as under:-

“1. Lacerated wound measuring 4.2 X 0.7 X 0.3 present over left parietal region of scalp. Bleeding is present. Patient advised surgeon opinion.

2. Lacerated wound measuring 1.5 X 0.4 X 0.2 present over the vertex of scalp. Bleeding is present. Patient advised surgeon opinion.

3. Lacerated wound measuring 6.3 X 0.5 X 0.3 present over right parietal region on scalp. Bleeding is present. Patient advised surgeon opinion. Underlying bone slightly depressed.

4. Lacerated wound measuring 1 X 0.2 X 0.1 present near injury no.3. Patient advised surgeon opinion.

5. Swelling diffuse in nature present over left cheek, near temporo mandibular joint. Patient unable to open his mouth. Advised dental opinion.

6. Complaint of pain right side of chest. No external injury present. Advised X-ray Chest.”

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7. Also discernible that petitioner is facing another criminal case bearing FIR No.101 dated 05.08.2022, under Sections 380, 457 and 411 IPC, registered at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar.
8. It has also come on record that in the aforesaid FIR, arrest warrants of petitioner has been issued by the Court of competent jurisdiction.
9. In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer of petitioner and the same is dismissed.
10. Ordered accordingly.
11. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
