The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for quashing the impugned letter dated 30.09.2022 (Annexure P-4) by which notice was issued to the petitioner as to why his passport should not be impounded.

Today, Mr. Amit Sharma, Advocate appearing on behalf of the Passport Authorities has submitted that he has instructions to state that the impugned show-cause notice (Annexure P-4) will be withdrawn by the Passport Authorities within a period of one week from today and the passport is already with the petitioner. He submitted that in view of the

above, the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the statement made by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Passport Authorities that the impugned show-cause notice will be withdrawn within a period of one week, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
