1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner is claiming the benefit of compassionate appointment on the ground that his father, who was working as a Science Master in the Education Department of Government of Haryana, unfortunately died on 29.04.2021 during the pandemic of Covid-19.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the application of the petitioner claiming the benefit as claimed in the present petition has already been forwarded by the School concerned to the Block Education Officer but no action has been taken so far, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case no final decision has been taken by the Government so far on the prayer of the petitioner seeking compassionate appointment, appropriate order on the prayer of the petitioner will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order and in case after the passing of the order, any benefit is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended to him within a further period of four weeks.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, no further orders are required to be passed in the present writ petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.
