1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.0022 dated 08.02.2020, under Sections 323, 324, 380, 427, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City, Dhuri, District Sangrur, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner No.1 is the daughter-in-law of the complainant – respondent No.2 and FIR, Annexure P1, is an outcome of a marital discord. He submits that false allegations have been levelled against the petitioners and the dispute has been amicably resolved between the parties by compromise, Annexure P2.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr.Arun Luthra, DAG, Punjab, accepts

notice of behalf of State-respondent No.1. Upon specific instructions from ASI Darshan Singh, he submits that after investigation, a cancellation report has been presented before the competent Magistrate.

5. Mr.Amitoj Singh, Advocate has put in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of complainant - respondent No.2. He has filed Power of Attorney, which is taken on record. He has admitted the factum of compromise and supports the prayer made in the petition.

6. Having heard counsel for the parties.

7. Noticing that a cancellation report has been submitted, petition is disposed of with liberty to the parties to appear before the competent Magistrate and make the necessary statements.
