The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.147 dated 20.07.2023 under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

The Counsel for the State has filed reply dated 02.12.2023 by way of affidavit of Mr. Surinder Singh, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Central Amritsar City in court today. The same is taken on record. A perusal of para 7 of the reply would show that though the petition is shown to have fired on the injured it had now been found that in fact it was Kamaljit Singh @ Kamal who had shot at the injured.

Be that as it may, as the petitioner is visible in the footage, I do not wish to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Faced with this situation, the counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the petition.

The petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.
