1. The petitioner – Dalbir Singh has filed civil revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India with the prayer to expedite the proceedings of Civil Suit No.CS/50/2022, titled Dalbir Singh Vs. Balwinder Kumar and others in which application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 read with Section 151 CPC is still pending.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the copy of amended plaint, Annexure P-1, copy of written statement, Annexure P-2, and thereafter he has placed on record copies of zimni orders passed in the aforesaid suit from time to time which shows that the suit was filed on 28.01.2022 and thereafter the counsel for the defendant appeared for the first time as per order dated 18.02.2022. The case was still pending for filing of written statement when the present petitioner filed an application under Order 6 Rule 17 read with Section 151 CPC as per zimni order dated 27.04.2022. The application for amendment of plaint was

ultimately decided as per order dated 22.11.2022. Again the case was adjourned for filing of written statement. The other counsel availed six dates for filing of written statement and now for the last 5 dates the case is being adjourned in the routine manner for consideration on stay application.

3. Considering the aforesaid interlocutory orders, the learned trial Court is directed to decide the application preferably within a period of one month from the passing of this order.

4. The civil revision is accordingly disposed of.
