The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.69 dated 26.04.2022 registered under Sections 379, 447, 511, 506, 147 IPC, at Police Station Lalru, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 17.11.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A status report dated 17.04.2023 by way of an affidavit of Darpan Ahluwalia, IPS, Asstt. Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Derabassi, District SAS Nagar, Mohali has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Salinder Kumar admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 17.11.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
