The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.156 dated 08.10.20222 under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act and Section 120-B IPC added later on vide order dated 17.11.2022 P.S. Sadar, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 17.11.2022 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Babandeep Singh, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Cantonment-V Jalandhar in Court today which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined investigation in terms of orders

dated 17.11.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 17.11.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
