1. Present revision petition has been filed by the petitioner-defendant No.1, challenging the order dated 09.08.2023 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali, whereby the application filed by the petitioner under Order VII Rule 10 C.P.C. read with Section 21 of C.P.C. for return of the plaint, was dismissed.

2. At the very outset, Mr. B.D. Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present revision petition with liberty to move an application for transfer of the civil suit from the Courts at Mohali to the Courts at Amritsar and for the said purpose, he

would move an appropriate application in accordance with law before such Competent Authority.

3. Present revision petition is disposed of as withdrawn, however, **liberty is granted to the petitioner to file an appropriate application, by giving detailed reason in it, for transfer of the Civil Suit from the Courts at Mohali to the Courts at Amritsar.**

4. However, it is also clarified that while deciding the application, for transfer of the civil suit, if any filed by the petitioner, observations given by the Courts in its impugned order dated 09.08.2023, would not affect the decision of the transfer application.

5. Needless to say, same would be decided by giving its detailed reasons, in accordance with law, without getting influenced with the order passed before this Court.
