Petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.PC seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.61 dated 22.09.2022 under Sections 21/25/29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Mehal Kalan, District Barnala (Annexure P-1).

Vide order dated 13.01.2023 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 13.01.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurmel Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.
