MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus for extension of parole for two months in FIR No.76 dated 22.11.2000, under Sections 302 IPC, registered at Police Station City Fazilka, District Ferozepur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has already been granted parole on 24.08.2023 by respondent No.3-Superintendent, Central Jail, Ferozepur for 56 days. Further, contends that petitioner is suffering from cancer and his treatment is going on from AIIMS Hospital, Bathinda and doctor has advised him for operation. Lastly, submits that an representation dated 22.09.2023 (P-2) for parole of 2 months is pending with respondent No.4; however, no action has been taken upon the same.

3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the time being, his grievance would be redressed, in case a

decision is taken on the above representation by the competent authority expeditiously.

4. Notice of motion.
5. At the asking of the Court, Mr. C.L. Pawar, Addl. A.G., Punjab., accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and does not oppose the prayer.
6. In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.4-Deputy Commissioner, Ferozepur, to decide the aforesaid representation by passing a reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
7. Ordered accordingly.
8. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
