The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a directions in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondent authorities to maintain law and order and ensure a peaceful exhibition of the movie titled as “Masand” across State of Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the movie has since then been released on 18.11.2022 and that there does not appear to be any subsisting grievance at this stage necessitating any further order from this Court.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
