Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.43 dated 27.04.2014, under Sections 420, 120-B, 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, '*the IPC*'), registered at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala, and all consequential proceedings, including the judgment dated 29.10.2018, passed by learned SDJM Nabha (P-2), on the basis of compromise dated 13.06.2015 (P-3), qua the petitioner.

2. Although, there is no formal notice of motion in this case, but Mr. C.L. Pawar, Addl.A.G., Punjab, on instructions from SI Chamkaur Singh, apprised the Court that entire prosecution evidence is over and as such, the trial is at fag end.

3. In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer for quashing of the FIR at this stage. Hence the petition is

disposed off accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy.

4. Needless to say that there would be no harm if the compromise so entered into between the parties is taken into consideration by learned Trial Court, in the interest of justice.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
