The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *mandamus* or any other suitable writ, order or directions, directing the respondent No.2 to issue the Police Clearance Certificate to the petitioner for his passport.

None has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner.
