ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

1. The petition herein is under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 14.
2. Learned counsel for respondent No. 4, at the outset, points out that the petition is liable to be dismissed outright, as a false affidavit has been filed by petitioner No. 2, overstating her age as 19 years, whereas she was actually born on 01.01.2007, as reflected in her Jan Adhar Card, where her date of birth is stated as 01.01.2007. This makes her a minor, and thus, petitioner No. 1 may face consequences for illegally entering into a relationship with petitioner No. 2, even if she has deposed that she is willingly staying with petitioner No. 1.
3. Be that as it may, I do not find any valid ground to entertain the present petition, and it is accordingly dismissed on the grounds of misstatement and concealment alone.
