By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has sought the relief of pre-arrest/anticipatory bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.189 dated 27.09.2022 registered at Police Station Phase-1, Mohali, under Sections 406 & 498-A IPC.

2. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh from the above-referred Police Station, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench on 17.11.2022, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and he is also not involved in any other

criminal case.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner named Rahul Ranjan by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 17.11.2022, is hereby made absolute.

4. However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
