ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J.

The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 28.09.2021, vide which interim order was passed in terms of the order passed in CWP-19331-2020.

In the order passed in the aforesaid writ petition, it is stated that no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner till the limit of fixed capital investment is exhausted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that now respondent No.3-Market Committee, Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran has issued a notice

for deposit of the market fee and rural development fee regarding purchase of Parmal.

Since there is no specific direction to respondent No.3-Market Committee, Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran for recovery of the said amount, no contempt is made out.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail the alternative remedy, in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
