The correctness of concurrent finding of fact arrived at by the Courts below is assailed by the plaintiff in the Second appeal on account of his conviction under Section 302 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act, 1959. He was convicted by the Court of the first instance.

Learned counsel for the appellant admits that the appeal filed by the appellant has also been dismissed. It is a case of honour killing. The appellant has killed his own daughter.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere is made out.
