Order dated 21.11.2022 passed by co-ordinate Bench of this
Court says as under:

“Through this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect his life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.3 to 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the dispute is between one Bahadur Singh and Ashok Kumar regarding lending of money; that the petitioner is a partner of Bahadur Singh and thus, has been involved in the present case and that the petitioner is unnecessarily being harassed by the Police of District Rupnagar.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Harkanwar Jeet Singh, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State

and prays for time to file an affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) concerned.”

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, present petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.
