1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to direct the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his other family members as they apprehend imminent threat at the hands of the private respondents. A further prayer has been made to direct the official respondents to look into the matter and take appropriate legal action against the private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 12.09.2023 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Gurdaspur-respondent No.2 and she shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate action against the private respondents, in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sanish Girdhar, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Gurdaspur, to look into the matter and take appropriate action as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law.

6. Disposed of.
