In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that starting from 01.04.2013 keeping in view the revised pay scale, the petitioners are entitled for the overtime allowance in the revised pay scale, which pay scale has not been granted to them by the respondents.

On being asked to point out the dates on which the petitioners had worked overtime after 01.04.2013, learned counsel for the petitioners was unable to point out any data from the pleadings so as to entitle the petitioners benefit of overtime allowance on revised pay scale.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondents by way of filing appropriate representation giving details of the period for which, the petitioners discharged their overtime duties but they

have not been paid overtime allowance after 01.04.2013 on the revised pay scale and respondents be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner so that petitioners do not suffer any prejudice.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case any claim giving details of the dates on which the petitioners worked overtime is submitted with the respondents, the same will be considered in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of any such claim and in case the petitioners are found entitled for any relief, the same will also be extended to them within a period of next 04 weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
