The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case registered vide DDR No.25 dated 18.06.2022 under Sections 307, 326, 324, 323, 452, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar City in FIR No.78 dated 10.06.2022 under Sections 307, 326, 324, 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar City.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 18.11.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from SI Sukhdev Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 18.11.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 18.11.2022 is

made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
